### VISITING PARTY NOTES – 2010

The following notes are provided for your information and guidance, and to help us make your day at Glenbervie an enjoyable experience.

As with most golf clubs the staff are obliged to strictly enforce the Rules of the Club, and this applies to both members and visitors.

**The organiser of the visiting party is responsible for ensuring that the members of his/her party adhere to the rules, and for the conduct of the players. Whilst we do not insist on the provision of handicap certificates, we would expect inexperienced golfers to be accompanied on the course by experienced players.**

On arrival, the organiser should make himself/herself known to the Secretary/General Manager.

**Days available for visiting parties:** Tuesday and Thursday at 9.00am and/or 2.00pm for the first tee off time. Friday is available for 2.00pm tee-off time.

**Numbers:** The Maximum number for a party is 48, unless as agreed with the Secretary.

**Play:** Play is from the yellow (gents) and red (Ladies) tees only.  
Markers for nearest the pin, longest drive etc can be obtained from the Professional's shop.  
Caddy cars are available for hire from the Professional's shop.  
Cost of round - £35/person    Cost of day ticket - £50/person

**Deposit:** £10 golf and £5 catering (£15 in total) per player on confirmation of booking.

**Two weeks prior to your outing you should confirm your requirements and numbers on the enclosed "Visiting Party Booking Confirmation" form.**

**Cancellation:** Should your outing be cancelled by you, the deposit may not be transferred to the following year and will not be returned. If your outing is cancelled because of closure of the course due to adverse weather conditions, every effort will be made to find an alternative date. If this is not possible, your deposit will be refunded. **If the number in your party on the day of play is less than the confirmed number on the booking form those deposits will be forfeited.**

**Company Advertising:**

Company flags may be flown from the flagpole at the 1<sup>st</sup> tee.

Company signage may be placed at the club entrance and on the 1<sup>st</sup> tee.

Promotional products e.g. cars may be placed on the grassy bank in front of the clubhouse by prior arrangement and subject to ground conditions being suitable.

## CLUB RULES

The Club requires Members and Guests to observe certain standards of dress.

### **On the Course**

Current acceptable golf attire and golf shoes are required to be worn. Tailored shorts are allowed.

**Not permitted are tracksuits, leisure suits, football shirts, denim jeans, cargo pants, combat style trousers, tee shirts and trainers.**

### **In the Clubhouse**

Smart casual wear and golf attire, as described above, including tailored shorts area acceptable. Members using the John Panton Lounge and Dining Areas are encouraged to dress more formally.

**Not permitted are tracksuits, leisure suits, football shirts, denim jeans, cargo pants, combat style trousers, tee shirts, trainers and golf shoes.**

In addition, outdoor clothing (e.g. anoraks) should not be worn, other than in the changing areas. Appropriate footwear must be worn, however children under 12 may wear trainers.

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**Mobile Phones must be switched off** on any part of the golf course including the practice area, **but may be used in the locker rooms or car park (only).**

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**Smoking is prohibited** throughout the Clubhouse and Locker Rooms, there is a designated smoking area to the west end of the clubhouse.

All food and drink will be supplied by the club.

Visiting Parties are requested to vacate the Clubhouse by 11.00 p.m.
