Our Story

Glenberrie Golf Club is a relatively new club by British standards, but we've fitted a lot into our mere 80 year history. From being designed by the famous James Braid to having John Panton, one of the UK's most successful golfers as our Golf Professional for almost 40 years, to presenting Jose-Maria Olazabal with his first UK Tournament win, some of the biggest names in golf have graced our greens.

As a testimony to the quality of our course, many major tournaments have been played at Glenberrie during our history: The Boys Amateur Championship, The Scottish Professional Championship, The Scottish Youths Open Amateur Stroke Play Championship and most recently, the SGU Club Championships.

Beginning his career on the links at Elie, James Braid was a successful golfer from a young age, winning his first tournament when he was just 8 years old. He went on to be the first golfer to win The Open Championship five times. His legacy, however, is as a very talented golf course designer. Among his designs are the 'King's Course' and the 'Queen's Course' at Gleneagles, and our very own Glenberrie Golf Course.

Braid's methodology was so successful that he effectively changed how golf courses were designed across the world. Carefully studying topographical maps and planning meticulously, Braid actually altered the terrain to create new and radical designs based around shot strategies. He believed that every hole should be challenging enough to force the player to question the kind of approach that should be made.

The tranquil natural beauty of Glenberrie Golf course offers an incredible setting for one of Braid's most challenging, ingenious designs. His connection with our course is a mark of quality for us, and is consistent with the high standards we uphold in every area of our club. Glenberrie is also a member of "The Association Of James Braid Courses" which enables our club members to receive preferential green fees at other association courses.

Our Facilities

Glenbervie Golf Club offers members an outstanding, tournament quality, golf course, some of the best practice facilities available in Central Scotland, and the latest in golf coaching technology. Our championship course requires strategy and skill for a low-scoring round, while offering beginners an enjoyable challenge. Designed by the famous James Braid, the course preserves the natural beauty of the parkland, using the natural hazards and minimising artificial interventions.

However, Glenbervie Golf Club is more than just an exceptional golf course.

The practice facilities include an expansive driving range with all

weather mats and covered bays along with a fabulous short game area. In addition, the short hole academy facility provides an excellent development area for junior members whilst offering other members the opportunity to hone their short game skills.

Our attentive, professional staff strive to provide the same high standards throughout our premises - whether you take advantage of our excellent Pro Shop and professional golf tuition, or our clubhouse's fine dining and function facilities. Glenbervie offers a beautiful venue for an excellent Scottish meal with incomparable views across the Ochil hills.

Membership

Glenbervie Golf Club accepts submissions for membership all year round either by recommendation from current members / other golf clubs, or through an application and interview process. Our membership standards make Glenbervie a safe and enjoyable place for men, women and juniors to play golf and a clubhouse environment welcoming for families of all ages.

There are five individual membership categories at Glenbervie Golf Club, three of which - Ordinary, Young and Country - offer full playing rights and two - Junior and Clubhouse - offer restricted playing rights, but full use of clubhouse facilities.

Ordinary Membership

Open to ladies and gentlemen aged 30 and over, with full access to all Glenbervie golfing and clubhouse facilities.

The entry fee is £1000 which can be paid by instalments - a £250 initial payment followed by 15 monthly payments of £50.

Annual subscription for 2020 is £1025 plus £60 for credit on the clubhouse loyalty card.

Reciprocal Offers

Glenbervie GC currently have reciprocal tee-time arrangements with Lanark GC, East Renfrewshire GC and Prestwick St Nicholas GC, each club offering their members the opportunity to play the other courses free of charge. Guidelines for each arrangement are detailed on the Club website.

Association Of James Braid Society

Glenbervie Golf Club is a member of "The Association of James Braid Courses", a collection of over 230 courses in Scotland, Ireland, Wales and England, plus one in New York, which were designed, re-designed or re-bunkered by James Braid. As such, Glenbervie Golf Club members can enjoy preferential green fee rates at all the other association courses.

Reduced Green Fees

Glenbervie has reciprocal agreements with Buchanan Castle GC, Dunblane New GC and Stirling GC which entitles our members to play these courses for 50% of the normal visitor green fee. Glenbervie members should make their booking in advance via the visiting club professional's shop.

Our Activities

GENTLEMEN

Gentlemen golfers of all standards are well served at Glenbervie, with regular strokeplay competitions on Wednesdays and Weekends, plus drawn competitions and multiple team events over the course of a season. Additionally, there is a regular calendar of social events and the opportunity to play for the highly successful Glenbervie club team.

LADIES

There are a number of different types of competitions for ladies. The tee is reserved on a Friday and alternate day medals offered at weekends too. But golf is not the only attraction for lady members at Glenbervie, with the Ladies Section Captain and her Committee very active in organising regular social events.

SENIORS

Seniors is another section within Glenbervie with its own Committee who organise regular strokeplay events and drawn competitions. There are also a number of friendly matches against other clubs across Scotland, not forgetting the Glenbervie Seniors Open event, one of the most eagerly anticipated events on the seniors "yellow book" competition rota.

JUNIORS

Juniors are the future life-blood of any golf club and Glenbervie has a strong focus on attracting and developing junior players. Many of the top gents players at the club today came through the junior ranks at Glenbervie, honing their golfing skills in the Sunday junior medals.
