



## CLUB RULES

Glenbervie Golf Club believes in upholding the traditions of golf, its values and heritage and therefore we kindly request that all members, guests and visitors observe the club rules and standards of dress.

### On the Course

- Current acceptable golf attire and golf shoes are required to be worn.
- Tailored shorts are allowed.
- Please tuck shirts into trousers / shorts
- Not permitted are tracksuits, leisure suits, football shirts, denim jeans, cargo pants, combat style trousers, tee shirts or trainers.

### In the Clubhouse

- Smart casual wear and golf attire, including tailored shorts are acceptable.
- Members using the John Panton lounge and dining room are encouraged to dress more formally.
- The wearing of smart jeans is permissible throughout the clubhouse.
- Torn, ripped or frayed denim, soiled or working clothes are not permitted
- Members, guests and visitors will be permitted to access the Alexander and McCowan Lounges when wearing soft spike golf shoes. All golfers should ensure shoes are clean and dry and without grass or mud deposits.
- Not permitted in any areas are tracksuits, leisure suits, football shirts or colours, combat style trousers or hats.

### Mobile Phones / Tablets

- Please switch off on all parts of the golf course including the practice area and 1<sup>st</sup> tee
- Phones must be switched to 'silent mode' throughout the clubhouse.
- Calls can be made from the car park, locker rooms and McCowan Lounge.

### Smoking

- Including the use of electronic cigarettes is prohibited in all areas of the clubhouse.
- There is a designated smoking area to the west end of the clubhouse.

*Members are asked to ensure that family and guests conform to the above rules.*

- All members of staff, when necessary, are empowered to request all those using the course and clubhouse facilities to conform to the above rules.
- Details of dress code infringements will be noted and action taken where necessary.
- The General Manager will ensure that all visiting parties will be advised of the above requirements in advance.
