

Glenbervie GC Open Competition Rules

Gents, Ladies, Seniors, Juniors & Mixed Foursomes Opens.



Eligibility:	Competitions are open to all amateur status golfers who are members of a recognized golf club and hold a current CONGU handicap*. (Handicap certificate to be available on request). Other criteria are included on the entry forms.
Format:	Competitions will be played in accordance with R&A / local rules and, with the exception of the open mixed foursomes, will comprise 18 holes of stroke play. In the open mixed foursomes, each pair will play alternate shots with a single ball.
Starting Times:	Range of starting times will be as indicated on the entry forms. Entrants are invited to indicate their preferred start time on the entry form. Best effort will be made to accommodate entrants preferred start time, but this cannot be guaranteed. Confirmed start times will appear on the Glenbervie GC website at least 2 weeks prior to the competition date. Entrants wishing to receive a paper copy of the draw should include a stamped-addressed-envelope (SAE) with their entry form.
Prizes:	Multiple prizes will be awarded for each competition, but no competitor may win more than one prize. In the event of a tie, winners will be decided over the last 9, then 6 then 3 holes, and thereafter as the competition committee decide.
In Event Of Cancellation:	If the competition is cancelled due to adverse weather conditions, entry fees will be refunded. It is the responsibility of entrants to confirm the cancellation with the club on the day of the competition. (Telephone 01324 562605 and select option 1 for the professional). Entrants not turning up when the competition is played will forfeit their entry fee.
Entry Acceptance:	Entries will be accepted on a first-come basis until the competition limit is reached. Further entries will be added to a waiting list in case of withdrawal by accepted entrants. The competition committee reserve the right to reject any entry.
Entry Fee:	Fee amount is indicated on the entry forms. Entries will only be accepted when accompanied by the fee. Fees may not be refunded for withdrawal after the closing date and will not be refunded for no-shows on the day of the competition.
Latest Entry Date:	Latest date for entries are indicated on the entry forms. Since Glenbervie GC open competitions are typically over-subscribed, early entry is recommended to avoid disappointment.
